MME Joins Psychiatry Network

Mission Mountain Enterprises, Inc., has established a partnership to provide psychiatry services in Ronan.

Our community-based program provides a variety of supports to people with developmental disabilities in Lake County. Some of these people also have mental illnesses. Our new partner also provides services for people with developmental disabilities and operates a mental health center that employs a dozen psychiatrists.

Providing mental health care in rural Montana presents many barriers—some based on tradition, some on geography and some on culture. MME has teamed up with a partner that has recruited doctors who understand and respect the nuances of Montana's population.

Mission Mountain has contracted with a partner to bring psychiatric care to its clients in Polson and Ronan. Psychiatric services will include face-to-face, on-site assessments as well as continuing care on-site and through the use of a tele-psychiatry network. Psychiatrists will also provide ongoing education, consultation and support to Mission Mountain staff as part of its partnership with the network of psychiatric services

Our new partner has been working under contract with the Montana Department of Public Health and

to develop Tele-psychiatry and help to bring psychiatry into communities across the state where there is a need. With the support of the state, they have been able to expand its video-conferencing capacity, including Ronan, and expand its staff of psychiatrists.

After the initial assessments, which occur on site in Polson and Ronan, people will receive follow-up and ongoing psychiatric services via teleconference with a psychiatrist. These appointments, set up at fixed intervals or as needed, are easy to coordinate even on short notice.

The Polson Community Foundation gave Mission Mountain Enterprises a \$1,500 grant to assist with start-up expenses of partnering with the network.
